Improved Compliance & Academic Collaboration

A leading private university with over 500 staff and researchers relied on M365 A5 for collaboration but faced challenges protecting student records, HIPAA data, and research IP. Krish implemented Microsoft Purview DLP, reducing accidental data leaks and supporting compliance with FERPA and HIPAA, while ensuring academic collaboration and security remained uninterrupted.

PROBLEMS

- Protecting Sensitive Data and Meeting FERPA & HIPAA Compliance: Critical student PII, health records, and research IP lacked safeguards, creating compliance and reputational risks.
- High Risk of Accidental Data Sharing Across Microsoft 365: Unaware faculty, staff, and students frequently shared sensitive files via Teams, OneDrive, and Exchange, increasing exposure.
- Lack of Centralized Data Loss Prevention (DLP) Controls: Without unified DLP, IT lacked visibility and control over sensitive data movement across Microsoft 365.

SOLUTIONS

- Data Discovery and Classification with Microsoft Purview: Identified sensitive data types including SSNs, health records, and education records using Microsoft Purview for stronger Microsoft 365 security.
- Centralized DLP Policies for FERPA and HIPAA
 Compliance: Designed and implemented DLP policies
 with sensitivity labels, policy tips, and audit mode to
 ensure FERPA and HIPAA compliance.
- Scalable Rollout with Monitoring and Continuous Optimization: Rolled out policies across 500+ users, enforced protection, enabled overrides, and established continuous monitoring with compliance reporting.

We improved Microsoft 365 security by setting up Purview DLP. This move supported compliance with FERPA and HIPAA, increased user awareness, and helped protect the company's data.
